If you would like to submit your proposed changes via paper copy you will find a link to a printable PDF for your convenience at the website listed above.

Please submit all proposed changes by Wednesday July 12th, 2017 to allow me to notify all delegates of changes that may be made in compliance with our state party rules. Delegates will receive notice via email 15 days prior to the Rules Convention in accordance with Rule 12 of our state party rules on July 27th, 2017.

All members of the Montana Democratic State Central Committee may vote at the Rules Convention.

- Chair, Vice Chair, State Committeeman, State Committeewoman, or their alternates from each recognized County Central Committee in the State of Montana.
 - *4 voting delegates maximum from each county*
- Every member of the Montana Democratic Party's Executive Board
- The President or Vice President from each of the Montana Democratic Party's Chartered Organizations

Rule 12 of the Montana Democratic Party Rules dictates that the rules may be amended by a vote of two-thirds of the members present.
